

1. ATSION FAMILY CAMP N 39 44.755 W 74 44.637

50 sites – family type, 6 people/2 vehicles/2 tents per site. Located on the North Shore of Atsion Lake off Atsion Road ½ mile west of Route 206. Picnic table and fire ring at each site. Flush toilets and hot showers, drinking water, and RV dump station in the area. Swimming permitted at Atsion Lake Recreation Area when lifeguards are on duty. Pets permitted with proper documentation **only at sites 26 to 34.**

2. GOSHEN POND CAMP N 39 44.681 W 74 45.644

Sites 1-16 – 6 people/2 vehicles/2 tents per site. *Group Site A - 50 people/15 vehicles maximum, Group Site B - 25 people/10 vehicles maximum, Group Site C - 15 people/6 vehicles maximum. Accessible by car. Located 1 ½ miles off Atsion Rd approximately 1 ¾ miles from Route 206. Sanitary facilities and drinking water available. Horseback Camping allowed. Pets permitted with proper documentation.

3. MULLICA RIVER CAMP N 39 41.424 W 74 40.515

Sites 1-10 – 6-12 people/2-6 tents per site – for canoe/kayakers and hikers. Located along the Mullica River approx. halfway between the Batsto and Atsion Offices on the Mullica River (Yellow) Trail, or 4 hours by canoe/kayak from the Mullica River Canoe Launch on Route 206. Sanitary facilities and drinking water available. No motor vehicle access. Pets are not permitted.

4. LOWER FORGE CAMP N 39 43.318 W 74 40.312

Sites 1-9 – 6 people/2 tents per site – for canoe/kayakers and hikers. Located along the Batsto River approximately 3 hours by canoe/kayak from Hampton Furnace and accessible from the Batona Trail. Sanitary facilities available. **No potable drinking water available.** No motor vehicle access. Pets permitted with proper documentation.

5. BATONA CAMP N 39 46.639 W 74 37.883

Sites 1-12 – 6 people/2 vehicles/2 tents per site. *Group Site A – 15 people/5 vehicles maximum. Campsite for Batona Trail located across from the Carranza Memorial. Accessible by car. Sanitary facilities and drinking water available. Pets permitted with proper documentation.

6. BUTTONWOOD HILL CAMP N 39 37.706 W 74 37.066

Sites 1-5 – 6 people/2 vehicles/2 tents per site. Accessible by car, located on Route 542 across from Crowleys Landing 1 ½ miles east of Batsto. Sanitary facilities available. **No potable drinking water available.** Pets permitted with proper documentation.

7. HAWKIN BRIDGE CAMP N 39 42.743 W 74 33.853

Sites 1-9 – 6 people/2 vehicles/2 tents per site. *Group Sites A, B, C, & D – 25 people/10 vehicles max. per site. Accessible by car or canoe, located north of Godfrey Bridge on west branch of Wading River. Sanitary facilities and drinking water available. Horseback Camping allowed. Pets permitted with proper documentation.

8 GODFREY BRIDGE CAMP N 39 41.388 W 74 32.769

Sites 1-34 – 6 people/2 vehicles/2 tents per site. Accessible by vehicle, located off Route 563 on west branch of Wading River. Sanitary facilities and drinking water available. Pets permitted with proper documentation.

9. BODINE FIELD N 39 39.237 W 74 31.263

Sites 1-22 – 6 people/2 vehicles/2 tents per site. *Group Sites A, E, & F – 15 people/6 vehicles max. per site. *Group Sites B, C, & D – 25 people/10 vehicles max. per site. *Group Sites G & H – 50 people/15 vehicles max. per site. Accessible by vehicle or canoe/kayak. Located off Route 679. Sanitary facilities and drinking water are available. Pets are not permitted.

CAMPING IS PERMITTED IN DESIGNATED CAMPING AREAS WITH A VALID PERMIT ONLY

Indvd'l Sites - \$3.00 per person per night for NJ residents. \$5.00 per person per night for out of state residents.

Groups Sites are a flat rate based on the maximum amount of persons allowed per site.

Lower Forge and Mullica River Campgrounds – hike or canoe/kayak in only.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Camping Permits must be picked up at either the Batsto or Atsion Office on the day of your check-in.

Must be 18 years of age or older to obtain a Camping Permit. No alcoholic beverages are permitted.

All sites have a fire ring for campfires (except in cases of fire restrictions.) There is a \$5.00 non-refundable transaction fee which applies to all reservations and walk-ins. Changes to a reservation may incur a \$2.00 or \$5.00 transaction fee. Cancelled reservations are subject to a \$40.00 fee (\$50 out-of-state residents)
